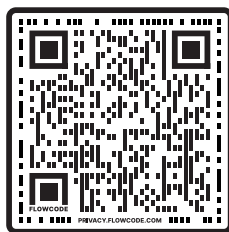

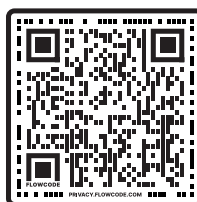

OHIO STATE USBC/BCAO ADULT YOUTH TOURNAMENT

Eligibility: This tournament is open to any Ohio USBC Certified bowler. Youth bowlers must be 18 or under as of August 1, 2023. Adult bowlers must be 19 or older as of August 1, 2023.

Division: All teams will compete in one of two divisions. Adult/Youth: bowler is 12 years of age or younger. Adult/Teen: youth bowler is 13-18 years of age. An optional scratch division will be offered. Scratch division will be a separate entry fee and prize fund with 100% of the entry being awarded in scholarships.

Average: Bowlers shall use their highest USBC certified average from 2022-2023 of 21 games or more. If no USBC certified average, a current average consisting of at least 15 games may be used. Bowler must provide a current league standing sheet to confirm current average. If a bowler (youth or adult) does not have either of the above averages, they will bowl scratch (225 average)

Handicap: based on 90% of 450 team average for all teams.

Entry Fee: \$60.00 per team. Breakdown: \$26.00 lineage, \$28.00 scholarships, \$6.00 administration. Optional scratch division will be an additional \$10.00 with all funds being awarded in scholarship funds.

Registration and Payment: On-line registration with entry fee payment is preferred. Paper entries may be mailed to: Ohio State USBC | P.O. Box 790 | Uniontown, Ohio 44685. Pre-registration deadline for both methods of registration and payment is September 20, 2023. Walk-in entries WILL be accepted after the deadline based on lane availability. A \$20 walk-in fee will be in effect. All walk-in fees will be added to the scholarship awards.

Prizes: One in six youth bowlers will receive a scholarship via S.M.A.R.T. The winning team in each division will receive an award. Optional singles brackets and jackpots will be available for both youth and adult separately.

Dress Code: Entrants are expected to wear suitable tournament attire. Clothing with alcohol/cigarette advertisements are prohibited. Inappropriate language, gestures or gambling will not be permitted. Electronic devices (including cell phones) are not permitted on the approach during delivery. USBC rules will govern all bowling during the tournament. Only tournament officials and bowlers are allowed in the bowlers' area.

All bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of powder or ANY foreign substance is prohibited. A dry towel is the only method of cleaning equipment once competition begins unless authorized by a tournament official. The bowlers, by voluntary participation, agree to comply to the final authority of the Tournament Manager. Any unforeseen situations will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretive judgement guided by the best interest of youth bowling and this event.
